Miami Lakes, FL - December 7, 2009 - The Puerto Rico Branch of JetStream Federal Credit Union has joined forces with Iniciativa Comunitaria de Investigacion Inc, to provide free AIDS testing for local residents. The event will take place in the JetStream parking lot on December 16th from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm.

More than 26 out of 100,000 people in Puerto Rico have AIDS, a rate nearly double that of the U.S. mainland, according to statistics from the Centers for Disease Control. "People's lives are in danger", said Assistant Manager, Luis Otero, "We joined this partnership to promote AIDS awareness and improve the level of health in our community."
